Dear Fellow Classmates,

Four years ago Enloe's first graduating Class of 1964 celebrated their 50th reunion. We now find ourselves walking in their same footsteps, as we celebrate our milestone 50th reunion on Saturday, September 29, 2018. The Class of 1964 pioneered a fundraising initiative as part of their 50th reunion activities to benefit The George A. Kahdy Enloe High School Alumni Scholarship Endowment, and challenged all other Enloe 50th class reunions to follow suit. In the "first" **Challenge** initiated by the Class of 1964 they raised \$6,000. In 2015, the Class of 1965 50th Reunion continued the **Challenge Fundraising Initiative** by surpassing their goal first established and raised \$10,000! The Class of 1966 50th reunion **Challenge** far surpassed their goal of \$11,000 by raising a whopping \$23,000, largely in part to a single most generous gift. Last year's Class of 1967 set their goal of \$12,000 and rallied to raise a total of \$14,700 collectively.

Therefore, we, the Class of 1968, have with great pride accepted the **Challenge** request passed on to us by our friends in the Class of 1967. It is a privilege that we include this initiative as a big part of our reunion, playing forward the **CHALLENGE** to benefit the Endowment and giving back to our Alma Mater. Not to be outshined, we have set a minimum goal of \$12,000 as our Class of 1968 reunion goal. With everyone's help we CAN make this happen or SURPASS!!

OUR CLASS CHALLENGE BEGINS NOW!!

Here are more details about the Scholarship Endowment and how you can make your contribution on behalf of our Class of 1968! In the summer of 2007, representatives and numerous donors from the first five William G. Enloe High School graduating classes (1964-1968) established The George A. Kahdy Enloe High School Alumni Scholarship Endowment named in honor of founding principal, George A. Kahdy. The Scholarship Endowment's sole purpose is to provide scholarships to qualifying Enloe graduates who demonstrate good character and integrity, academic achievement, service and leadership to school and community, involvement in school activities, and financial need. The first scholarship (one time award) of \$4,000 was made in 2008. Today, the Endowment awards one \$10,000 Multi-Year Scholarship annually, for which the recipient receives \$2,500 per year over 4 years. As the balance of the Endowment continues to grow, the number and value of the awards will grow also.

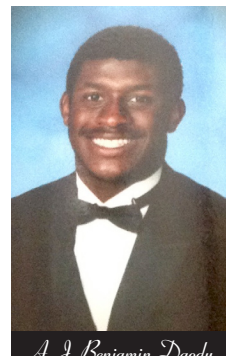

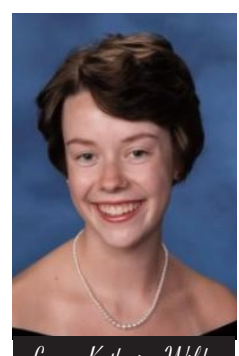
